Whistleblower's Checklist

BEFORE contacting Allison Legal or any experienced Whistleblower attorney, look through the list of questions below.

YOU DON'T NEED to have all the answers, but it will help you and the attorney work on the first big question you're asking:

"Do I Have A Case?"

- The Company:** • lines of business; • public or private; • how big; • headquarters location; etc.
 - You At The Company:** • your position, job title; your department; • how long at the Company; • still working there; • if not, since when and why; • organization structure; • structure of management and departments (i.e., organization chart).
 - You and Your Info:** • have you told anyone about what you think is the fraud?' • do others that work there know what you know?
 - The Fraud:** • describe the fraud; • what actions make up the fraud; • is there a cover up of the fraud.
 - The Evidence:** • describe what evidence you have (documents, emails, recordings, etc.).
 - Your Status:** • have you been retaliated against?
